

Press Release - Regulated Information¹

Public offer for the subscription of Green Retail Bonds in the context of two bond issues of 4 years and 6 years coupled with a gross coupon of 3 % and 3.50 % for minimum amounts of, respectively, €15 million and €50 million and maximum amounts of, respectively, €25 million and €75 million.

ATENOR announces that on 12 March 2021 it will launch an issue of 4-year and 6-year green bonds for a minimum amount of, respectively, €15 million and €50 million (each series of such bonds, hereinafter referred to as a "Series") in the form of a public offer in Belgium open to retail investors and, to a certain extent, qualified investors.

The net proceeds from the public offer, which should amount to €65 million in case of placement of the minimum amount and €100 million in case of placement of the maximum amount (excluding costs and fees related to the issue, estimated at € 100.000, supported by Atenor), will be exclusively allocated to the financing or refinancing, in whole or in part, green and energy-efficient real estate projects that contribute to Atenor's environmental objectives. These projects meet certain eligibility criteria such as; BREEAM minimum "Excellent", WELL Core and Shell; with an energy performance level corresponding to a primary energy consumption of a maximum defined by country (included in the EPC, Energy Performance Certificate).

As an actor committed to the development of sustainable cities, ATENOR targets retail investors and is offering them the opportunity to participate in the financing of its projects by subscribing to one of the two tranches of its first "Green Retail Bond".

The issue prices are fixed, for the 4-year bonds and the 6-year bonds respectively, at 101.625 % and 101.875 % of the nominal value of the bonds with gross coupons of 3 % and 3.50 % payable on 19 March of each year. The gross actuarial yields based on the issue price amount to 2.57 % and 3.15 %, while the net actuarial yields (that is, the gross yield less the withholding tax of 30%) amount to 1.68 % and 2.11 %.

The bonds will be governed by Belgian law and carry the right to redemption at 100% of their nominal value upon maturity, on 19 March 2025 and 19 March 2027.

The nominal value of the bonds is €1.000 and the minimum subscription amount is equal to €1.000.

The green projects to which the net proceeds of the issued bonds are allocated in accordance with the reference framework, which has been implemented by Atenor based on the ICMA's Green Bond Principles and the Loan Market Association's Green Loan Principles, may not meet future legislative or regulatory requirements, or may not meet all investor expectations regarding sustainability performance, or may not continue to meet the relevant eligibility criteria.

The subscription period will run from 12 March 2021 (9.00) until 16 March 2021 (17.30) without prejudice to early closing for each Series (see Section 8 of the "Subscription and Sale" section of the Prospectus), independently of each other, as from 12 March 2021 at 17.30. All subscriptions that have been validly submitted by retail investors to the arrangers before the end of the minimum subscription period will be taken into account for the purpose of allotment of the bonds, it being understood that in the event of oversubscription, a reduction may apply. Retail investors are thus encouraged to subscribe to the bonds on the first working day of the subscription period before 17.30 (CET). Moreover, if the subscription period remains open after 17.30, as from that time, the Bonds may be allotted on the basis of the principle of "first come, first served". The first payment date of the bonds is set at 19 March 2022.

A listing of the bonds issued by Atenor on Euronext Brussels is foreseen. The expected date for the admission is 19 March 2021.

Investors are obliged to inform themselves of the costs that may be charged to them by financial intermediaries.

Belfius Bank and KBC Bank are acting as the arrangers for the issue and placement of the bonds.
